Be It Further Resolved That:	This be implemented by way of an honor system in which students will remain only on the first floor with the UTA Police taking corrective action against any violating student and/or a fine being administered; and
Be It Further Resolved That:	This allows for the staff members to clean the library on floors 2-5; and
